This schedule is based on a 196 day contract. Contracts of other lengths will be adjusted accordingly based on the daily rate.

Any teacher, upon retirement shall be paid a \$6,000 retirement supplement. To be eligible, a teacher has to have served Flagler County for 10 years and be 55 years old, or have 30 years of service (10 of which must be in Flagler County) at any age at time of official retirement.

The payment date shall be in the first payroll after confirmation of applicability by the Personnel Department.

A \$1,000 Longevity Increment will be added to the pay for each year past step 22 on the salary schedule.

The first year a teacher comes to Flagler School District, the highest possible placement on our salary schedule will be Step 22 on the salary schedule.
