Graduate FAQ

1. How do I know if I'm on track to complete my coursework in a timely manner?

You should be taking classes per your Plan of Study (POS). If you do not have a POS, need to make changes in it, or have taken courses out of sequence, it is important to see your faculty advisor as soon as possible. 2. How do I know which classes to take?

Refer to your plan of study. If you have questions or need to make changes, contact your faculty advisor.

3. What do I do if I need an override?

Most graduate students will not need overrides since course availability is structured based on plans of study. Should you require one because of a unique circumstance (e.g., change to plan of study, completion of undergraduate prerequisites), please see an advisor during open advising hours.
