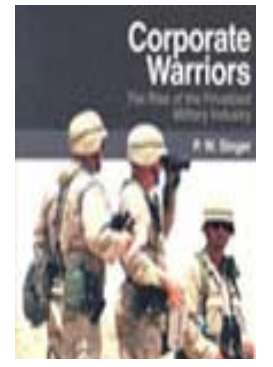

Keynote Speaker:
Dr. Peter Warren Singer

Dr. Singer is considered one of the world's leading experts on changes in 21st century warfare. He has written for the full range of major media and journals. Peter Warren Singer is Senior Fellow and Director of the 21st Century Defense Initiative at the Brookings Institution.

His first book **Corporate Warriors: The Rise of the Privatized Military Industry** (Cornell University Press, 2003) pioneered the study of the new industry of private companies providing military services for hire, an issue that soon became important with the use and abuse of these companies in Iraq. Dr. Singer's upcoming book, **Wired for War** (Penguin, 2009), will look at the implications of robotics and other new technologies for war, politics, ethics, and law in the 21st century. The work has already been featured in the video game *Metal Gear Solid 4: Guns of the Patriot*, as well as in presentations to audiences as diverse as the Air Force Institute of Technology to the National Student Leadership Conference.
