

Senior Scholar Program

The Senior Scholar Program is an opportunity for outstanding undergraduate students to experience graduate level coursework prior to completion of their bachelor's degree.

Exemplary students looking at applying for the Criminal Justice Masters Program and continuing their education after their undergraduate careers are encouraged to become Senior Scholars.

Eligibility Requirements

- Completion of 90 credit hours (senior standing)
- Completion of ALL core classes in Criminal Justice undergraduate program
- 3.0 cumulative GPA **OR** 3.0 Criminal Justice GPA

Program Policies

- Only 5000 level course can be taken**
- Up to 9 credit hours may be taken and transferred into Master's program upon acceptance
- Courses can count towards upper-level Criminal Justice elective credit for the undergraduate degree and be transferred to the graduate program for dual credit

***Note: Any course with both undergraduate and graduate sections will not be considered (i.e. seminars and study abroad) ***
