UCF Presidential Doctoral Fellowship

The University of Central Florida offers Presidential Doctoral Fellowships to superior graduate students who are newly enrolling at UCF in one of its doctoral programs or tracks. These awards provide multi-year support to the most qualified applicants to the institution.

All new doctoral students who are entering in the Spring 2009, Summer 2009, or Fall 2009 semesters as full-time students pursuing doctoral degrees are eligible to be nominated by their program for this award. Stipend payments will begin in the Fall 2009 semester.

Duration of Award:

Maximum of four years of support.

Fellowship Stipend:

\$17,000 per year for four years in fellowships and assistantships.

Tuition Support:

UCF College of Graduate Studies pays the charges for your course hours during each year of the award. This does not include the payment of local fees (health fee, athletic fee, building fee, etc.).

Health Insurance:

A UCF Student Health Insurance Policy through Aetna Student Health will be provided for your individual coverage for the duration of the award.

Criteria for Fellowship Selection:

- Submission of a completed admission application and all test scores (including TOEFL for international students) by January 15, 2009.
- Admission to a UCF doctoral program.
- GRE score of at least 1300 on the combined verbal-quantitative sections, or GMAT score of at least 630.
- Evidence of awards, recognition, or honors.
- Evidence of experience in the field.

Fellowship Description:

- UCF College of Graduate Studies provides a \$17,000 fellowship in the first and third years.
- The college and department provide a \$17,000 fellowship or graduate assistantship in the second and fourth years of the award. Support after year 4 will be provided at the discretion of the department and college.

Fellowship Obligations:

- Maintain good academic standing and acceptable progress to degree in the graduate school and college.
- Must be enrolled full-time as a graduate student in a doctoral program or track during the tenure of the award (at least 9 hours of course work during the Fall and Spring semesters; summer enrollment is optional, but fellowship recipients may receive summer tuition support for 6 hours of course work during the Summer semesters).
