	<p>Bob Morin Instrumental in Obtaining Over a Million Dollar Grant for Orange County Fire Rescue</p>
Tuesday	<p>Bob Morin received the good news last week that his hard work has paid off in the form of a \$1,481,142 grant award to the Orange County Fire Rescue unit. This is one of the largest single grants ever awarded by the Assistance to Firefighter Grant Program. It will provide Emergency Vehicle Preemption Traffic Signal Systems for 300 high traffic intersections in Orange County, which will allow firefighters and rescue vehicles to change traffic signals on approach so that the flow of traffic is unimpeded -- making for a safer and quicker emergency response.</p>

Set appointments and have a colleague or dean sit in OR request that police intervention be available. • If confronted by an angry student: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Remain Calm - Do not react at his/her level. - Attempt to Have a Colleague Present - Determine the Severity of the Situation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Is it a 911, non-emergency or non-police matter? - You have the right to ask her/him to leave! - Document the Incident - Report It to Your Supervisor*
