Monday	<p>Dr. Kapucu Quoted in Florida Today On May 23rd 2006 <i>Florida Today</i> published an article entitled "Newcomers must prepare – study: Few have evacuation plan, disaster kits." In this article Dr. Kapucu stated "Some newcomers, however, are not as prepared as they think they are." In his recent hurricane preparedness survey Dr. Kapucu found that 70 percent of Central Florida residents said they were ready. But only 11% percent actually had done the work to supplement readiness, such as preparing a disaster kit, having evacuation plans and practicing a disaster plan with family members. This study was completed by Dr. Kapucu with the help of graduate students.</p>

Using a large national study of more than 12,000 physicians, she found that there was a statistically significant income gap between male and female physicians. The factors that influence the income gap are different between man and women.
