## **Course Description**

The course outline is based on the FSU CPEIP Harris Institute's experience in providing Infant Mental Health training, working the Harris Foundation's Professional Development Network of training programs, and the empirically-based Infant Mental Health Therapist Competency Framework (published in the *Infant Mental Health Journal*). Class topics, readings and activities have been developed to provide students with foundational knowledge for working with children under the age of five, and to help students begin to develop assessment, treatment planning and clinical practice skills in work with young children and their families. Students will be introduced to screening tools, observation forms, interviews with children under five and their parents and will learn how an integrative approach is utilized to assess and treat the various problems presented by this population.
